Picture Frame Crayon Ornament




Supplies:

You will need:

- Crayons
- Foam sheets
- Cardstock
- Ribbon
- Glue
- Mod Podge
- Each student's picture.

Here are the steps on how to make the picture frame crayon ornaments:







Step 2: Hole punch two holes at the top of the

rectangle.

Step 3: Tie string or ribbon through the two holes.



<u>Step 4:</u>

Using regular bottle glue, have your

students glue crayons onto their foam rectangle. They will first glue the two crayons on each side.

They can choose if they want their two crayons on each side to go the same or opposite directions.

<u>Step 5:</u>

Next, have your students glue the top and bottom two crayons.

Let the glue completely dry before moving on to the next step. If the glue is not completely dry the crayons will slide out of place on the next step.

<u>Step 6:</u>

After the glue has dried, have your students paint the crayons with Mod Podge.



<u>Step 7:</u>

Add glitter to the wet Mod Podge and then let it dry.

<u>Step 8:</u>

Next, have your students glue their $(1\frac{1}{2}x2)$ picture in the middle of their frame. I printed my student's pictures from my computer and then laminated them for extra durability.



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
