Supplies Needed (Click on the links to go to Amazon):

- Plastic Punch cups
- Cardstock Paper
- Fake snow
- Iridescent Glitter
- Hot glue gun
- Glitter Pipe cleaners



Instructions:

- 1. Using a plastic cup, trace the circle on a piece of cardstock paper. Cut it out.
- 2. Take a photo of your child and cut around the edges so no background shows.
- 3. Bend the bottom of the photo and hot glue it to the cardstock paper so the photo is standing up.
- 4. Add some fake snow and glitter around the photo.
- 5. Hot glue around the edges of the cup and stick it on the circle piece of paper.
- 6. Bend a pipe cleaner to make an oval and hot glue it to the top of the cup.
- 7. Hang it up on the tree or give it as a gift!
